Narrative (Lieutenant Gockstetter):

On August 15, 2024, 0534 hours, Cleveland Dispatch received a call of a crash on I-80 (Ohio Turnpike) eastbound near milepost 49. Troopers responded to the scene. Sergeant Devon Black arrived on scene first at 0537 hours. He arrived on scene at the west side of the scene. As Sergeant Black approached, he came to people laying in the road. There was a citizen that advised the son was dead and pointed to the east. The citizen gave an assessment of the injuries of the other people laying on the ground. There was a black SUV (Unit 2) off the south side of the road and a semi (Unit 1) overturned in the toll booth lanes. There was a juvenile female and an adult male laying on the ground. An adult female was sitting on the ground beside them. Sergeant Black ran to the overturned semi. The driver of the semi, Hashim Hall, was trapped inside the semi but was talking. Sergeant Black called for additional resources to respond to the scene. Unit 2 had four occupants and Unit 1 had one occupant.

The Ohio Turnpike near milepost 49 is a four-lane highway, divided by a cement median barrier wall. As you approach the area of the crash from the west, traveling eastbound, there are signs posted for the toll plaza. The eastbound lanes turn into three lanes, the right and center can be used to exit the main line to the toll plaza. The left and center are used to continue straight. There is an overhead sign designating each lane of travel. The left and center lanes are used as E-ZPass lanes and are intended for traffic to continue traveling at the speed limit eastbound. As the lanes split into four, there is a center gore area with white pavement markings. As you continue east, there is a short segment of guardrail prior to the cement divider between the toll plaza lanes and the eastbound fast lanes. There was a light fog in the area just prior to the crash.

The initial impact occurred in the right lane, just after the four lanes split for the toll plaza. Both units were traveling eastbound. Unit 2 slowed and was struck in the rear by Unit 1. There were gouges and tire marks indicating the area of impact. After impact the vehicles traveled southeast, through the gore area and onto the toll plaza lanes. The commercial vehicle overturned. The median guardrail, prior to the cement median barrier was destroyed. The trailer for Unit 1 was facing eastbound, leaning to the right side. The hazmat contents were laying in the lanes. Unit 1 was on its top. Unit 2 was off the south side of the road in the grass, facing west.

Eastbound traffic had stopped and was backing up due to the crash. At 0554 hours, a secondary fatal crash (#89-0326-26) occurred at milepost 48 eastbound in the backed-up traffic. At 0601 hours, after the fire department arrived on scene. A firefighter advised Sergeant Black that the commercial was hazmat and was hauling acetone and sulfuric acid. First responders worked to extract the commercial driver, later identified as Hashim Hall. Once extracted, he was transported by ground to University of Toledo Medical Center. At 0624 hours, westbound traffic had slowed as people were slowing as they passed this crash. A third fatal crash (89-0327-48) occurred in the westbound backup

The juvenile female, Tenzin Choedon, was ejected from the vehicle. She was flown by life flight to St. Vincent Medical Center with life threatening injuries. The adult male passenger, Tenzin Drukgyal, was also ejected from the vehicle. He was pronounced deceased at the scene at 0644 hours by Lieutenant Thorne, Springfield Township Fire Department. The juvenile male, Dawa Norbu, was ejected from the vehicle and was pronounced deceased at the scene by Lieutenant Thorne at 0644 hours. The driver, Thupten Choedon, was transported by ground to St. Vincent Medical Center with serious injuries. Ms. Choedon was the only occupant in Unit 2 that was not ejected.

Once the victims were removed and transported to the hospital, Springfield Township Fire Department set up a 150' perimeter around the hazmat material that was spilled. The hazmat materials were identified as sulfuric acid, acetone, diesel fuel, mesityl oxide, mesitylene vapor, sulfuric acid vapor, and acetone vapor. Toledo Fire Department's Hazmat Team 6 and 7 arrived on scene at 0714 hours. They ordered all persons exposed to the hazmat be decontaminated at the scene and transported to the hospital via ambulance. Five state troopers, one motor carrier inspector and two turnpike maintenance workers were transported by Springfield Township EMS

to the University of Toledo Medical Center at 0914 hours. The associated case report is 24-0912002-0189. All first responders that were transported to the hospital were released a couple hours later.

Lieutenant Erica Gockstetter went to St. Vincent Medical Center to make contact with the driver of Unit 2, Thupten Choedon. Ms. Choedon had just gone in for surgery and they advised they would contact us when she was able to speak. Later that evening at 2104 hours, Trooper Logan Kirkendall made contact with Ms. Choedon at the hospital. He informed Ms. Choedon that the adult male passenger, Tenzin Drukgyal, had died. Ms. Choedon stated she was the driver. She said she had slowed down and was planning on going to the tolls. She said her son, Dawa, was sitting in the second row on the passenger side. Ms. Choedon said her daughter, Tenzin, was sitting in the second row in the middle seat and the adult male, Tenzin Drukgyal, was sitting in the second row on the driver's side

Trooper Fred Anderson made contact with Hashim Hall at the University of Toledo Medical Center at 2015 hours. Mr. Hall gave Trooper Anderson his attorney's card and refused to give a statement. He was provided the information for the crash.

Around approximately 1930 hours, the vehicles were towed from the scene by Bubba's Towing. Troopers on scene completed vehicle inventories. The scene was cleared at approximately 2153 hours.

Unit 1, 2019 Mack Semi, sustained damage to the entire power unit. The cab was disconnected from the unit. The roof was crushed down, the dash was pushed inward and the floor was pushed up. The driver's seat was damaged. The front drive tire was flat and off the wheel bead. The trailer of Unit 1 was a white box trailer. It sustained damage to the rear walls and wheels.

Unit 2, 2015 Toyota Highlander, sustained heavy damage to the rear of the vehicle. The interior of the vehicle as exposed in the rear. The rear bumper was gone and pushed inward. The third row seats were pushed down and forward. The entire left rear side panels were pushed forward beside the driver's door. There was a white panel from the semi attached to the roof of Unit 2. The second-row seats were damaged and pushed forward. The driver's seat belt was extended and locked indicating the driver was wearing her seat belt at the time of the crash. There were no other seat belts extended or bucked. The roof, windshield and hood were scratched and damaged indicating the vehicle rolled over during the crash. The entire vehicle sustained damages with the most serious damage being at the rear.

On August 16, 2024, Lieutenant Gockstetter and Trooper Willie Richardson met the family of Unit 2 at the tow yard and released the contents of the vehicle to the family. Trooper Richardson went to St. Vincent Medial Center to ask Ms. Choedon additional questions. Ms. Choedon stated that she slowed down from 70 MPH to 50 MPH near the toll plaza because she needed to pay and was struck in the rear. Ms. Choedon started to cry as she expressed her confusion with the toll plaza. She said there are too many and they should just take one payment. She said she doesn't mind paying but it is too confusing. She said the vehicle was still moving at the time she was struck and she didn't remember which lane she was in. She stated they were traveling from Minnesota to New York. Ms. Choedon said she had been driving since 0300 or 0400 hours.

District One OIS obtained a warrant and seized the cell phone from Unit 1. District One Crash Reconstruction handled vehicle downloads, a map of the scene, drone video, and a reconstruction report. These reports will be supplemented with the crash when available.



The front seat passenger of Unit #6 was transported to the Toledo Hospital and sustained non life threatening injuries. His injuries sustained were broken ribs.



Driver of Unit #5 was provided with a crash report number via cell phone.

Victim witness was provided to all occupants of Units #2 through 5.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Reconstruction team responded to the scene and assisted with scene investigation.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Licensing and Commercial Standards team also responded to the scene and conducted inspections on all three commercial vehicles.

The crash investigation determined Unit #1 to be traveling westbound on the Ohio Turnpike (Interstate 80) near mile post 50.8, Swanton Township, Lucas County. Units #2,3,4, and 5 were all westbound on IR 80 (Ohio Turnpike) in the right lane slowing or stopped for traffic. Unit #1 failed to maintain assured clear distance ahead and struck Unit #2 in the rear, then Unit #3 in the rear, and then Unit #4 in the rear before finally jackknifing. When Unit #4 was struck, it was pushed into the rear of Unit #5.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Licensing and Commercial Standards team was able to obtain a hard drive to Unit #1's dash camera footage.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Office of Investigations Services obtained a warrant for the hard drive subscriber information, video, vehicle diagnostics, and any other data stored in the hard drive.

The hard drive was taken as evidence by Trooper L. Rodriguez, U-1905, and provided the driver of Unit #1 with an HP-60.

The driver of Unit #1 was asked to submit to a voluntary chemical test and provide a sample of his urine. He later agreed and provided Lieutenant R. Schack, U-1491, a sample of his urine at approximately 0840 hours. The
